

RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE BC

Construction of a new 75,000 sf “house” for Ronald McDonald House BC is well underway. The new house will serve 73 BC and Yukon families with severely sick children who are being treated at BC Children’s Hospital. This is a wonderful charity with a very important goal to help families through one of the most difficult times in any parent or child’s life.

The 30 million dollar project is using a hybrid CLT (cross laminated timber) + TJI structure. The design is based on 4 interconnected houses each serving roughly 18 families. Each house is at a slightly different phase in the construction process making this a perfect time to see the techniques involved.

This summer, MGA will be offering seminars and site visits of the Ronald McDonald House Project. (Original Firm: mcfarlane green biggar ARCHITECTURE and DESIGN; completed under MGA | Michael Green Architecture).

This two hour site visit / seminar is eligible for 2 AIBC Core LUs. The session will consist of an hour discussion on site of the structural design, envelope design (masonry on CLT substrate) and unique features of the design and a one hour tour of the construction site to review details first hand.



COURSE SCHEDULE

Sessions will be held on Saturday mornings at 9:00 am starting July 13th. We will offer classes with 20 people per session. We will offer as many sessions as we need to based on the demand.

Sessions will be held at the Ronald McDonald House BC Construction Site. Participants will meet at the site office at the corner of Heather and 31st, prior to the 9:00 am start time.

All participants must bring steel toed shoes, hard hats and reflective vests.
